# ABOUT THE EVENT ORGANIZER:

Meet the EEC: The Elkhart Environmental Center is the largest public greenspace in the city of Elkhart. It features over 66 acres of picnic areas, a canoe/kayak launch, and trails through prairies, forests, and wetlands. It's the perfect place to spot local wildlife, as it's home to a variety of songbirds, turtles, deer, foxes, turkeys, and so much more—you never know what you'll find! A newly paved section of the River Greenway Trail runs through part of the property along the Elkhart River, which is a great path for cyclists and pedestrians.

The EEC is a beautiful place to visit, but that's not all it is! The EEC also hosts educational and outreach programs, events, and volunteer opportunities on a regular basis. And have we mentioned the new solar panels and wind turbine? The EEC is the first city department to get renewable energy, and has interactive displays showing the live energy generation and money savings.

So, yeah, it's kind of a big deal. You should totally check it out.

The trails are open from dawn to dusk every day. The EEC Visitor's Cabin is open 8 AM – 5 PM Monday through Friday and provides educational displays, access to an informational resource table, and a kids' Learning Loft.
